Bristol International Balloon Fiesta Project, operational and site management for one of Europe's largest outdoor events and the second biggest hot air balloon event in the world. The Fiesta attracts media attention from all over the world and features over 250 exhibitors, traders and caterers and up to 500,000 visitors all set within an historic parkland.

Bristol Harbour Festival REM have provided a variety of services to Bristol City Council over the course of a 20 year relationship with the Bristol Harbour Festival. Since 2013, we have been the principal contractor and as such are responsible for income generation, creative programming, site management and event production. It is a high profile event designed to promote the city's cultural offering and help support tourism and the local economy. The Festival attracts over 250,000 visits over the weekend.

Run Bristol Site management and event control for the Bristol Half Marathon and 10k Races. The Bristol Half Marathon was first held in 1989 when it attracted 1,000 runners. By 2015, this had grown to over 16,000 and the event is now firmly established on the national calendar with a developing international reputation. The race celebrated its silver anniversary in 2013 and is now one of Bristol's most prestigious sporting events.



Liverpool International Music Festival – production and site management Liverpool has a long and rich musical heritage from Merseybeat to the Beatles. The Liverpool International Music Festival (LIMF) has become the current voice of the global music city. Consisting of Commissions, Academy and the grand finale Summer Jam, LIMF takes in several iconic Liverpool venues, attracting tens of thousands of music lovers.

European Green Capital 2015 Producers of the official Opening Ceremony with an audience of 500 people including European Commissioners, international delegations, government and national officials. Suppliers of logistics, safety management and technical production for "Bridging the Gap" in which a 120 metre long wire was suspended between warehouses on the city's harbourside to symbolise the difference between our green intentions and actions. Friday and Saturday evening of the 2015 Harbour Festival finished with a projection mapping and special effects show on the harbourside's amphitheatre building, designed to highlight Bristol's year as European Green Capital as well as the richness of city life.

ISO 20121:2012

ISO 20121 is a management system standard that has been designed to help organisations in the events industry improve the sustainability of their event related activities, products and services. It was created as an international standard to coincide with the London 2012 Olympics. In simple terms, ISO 20121 describes the building blocks of a management system that will help any event related organisation to: continue to be financially successful, become more socially responsible and reduce its environmental footprint.

COMMUNICATIVE

Communication is important – we put a huge amount of emphasis on this. We believe it builds strong relationships, a feeling of security, trust and a healthy exchange of ideas and opinions.

The first step is to decide who gets what information and how often. The client sits at the top of the tree and we provide management reports detailing revenue, ticket sales, marketing activity, progress towards targets and everything else you need to know. This is backed by budget updates and a "traffic light" based report highlighting areas for action, areas that are becoming sensitive and areas that are proceeding well.
